**4<sup>th</sup> November:** Eastern Europe  
**18<sup>th</sup> November:** Western Europe.

### Air Mail:

**28<sup>th</sup> November:** Operational HM Forces Mail.  
**3<sup>rd</sup> December:** Asia, Far East, Japan & New Zealand.  
**4<sup>th</sup> December:** Australia  
**8<sup>th</sup> December:** Eastern Europe/ Greece  
**9<sup>th</sup> December:** Canada, Poland  
**12<sup>th</sup> December:** USA, HM Forces  
**13<sup>th</sup> December:** Western Europe

## PARCELS

Royal Mail **1<sup>st</sup> Class, 2<sup>nd</sup> Class** and **Signed-For Small Parcels** have just got bigger! **Max New size:** 45cm x 35cm x 16cm. **Max Weight:** 2 kg.

To make life easier for everyone, the Post Office has provided a Small Parcel Size Guide Box, which is available behind the counter so you can easily check the size of your parcels.

Sending 1-2kg Royal Mail **2<sup>nd</sup> Class Small Parcels** through the Post Office is now cheaper until the 18<sup>th</sup> January. For 2<sup>nd</sup> Class Small Parcels up to 2kg there is now one price band instead of two. It now costs **£2.80** (old price for 1-2kg parcel was £3.80).

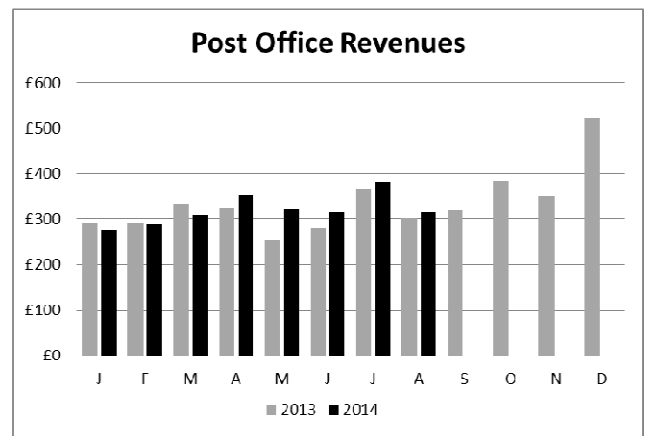
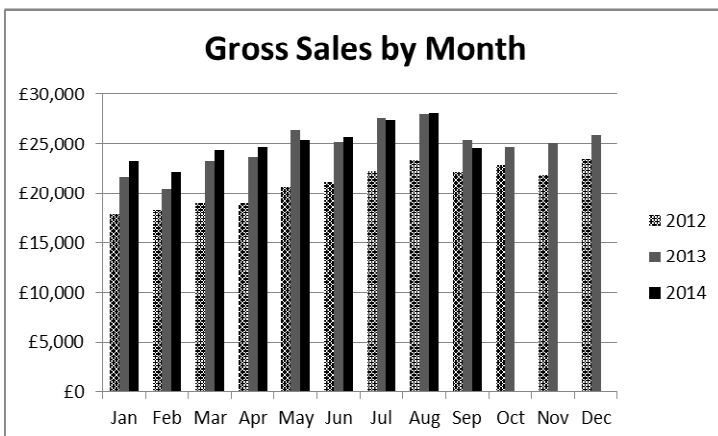
The same goes for 1-2kg Royal Mail **2<sup>nd</sup> Class Signed-For Small Parcels**. Up to 2kg it now costs **£3.90** (old price £4.90 for a 1-2kg parcel).

There is also a new promotional lower weight band of **0-60g** for International Standard Small Parcels:  
Europe - £2.34: World Zone 1 – £2.98  
World Zone 2: £3.13
